



WASL Data/EALRS Learning Targets Activity

Activity Steps

For this activity we will first walk through an example together. Then each of us will complete the Trend/EALRs Learning Targets Worksheet for our own school.

For today's exercise we will complete the worksheet by writing the data and learning targets in by hand. It can also be done by cutting and pasting from the reports on the OSPI website and from the EALRs outline document.

For this activity you will need:

- A copy of the WASL Trend/EALRs Learning Targets Worksheet (in your manual)
- Outline of the Washington State EALRs (in your manual)
- A pen or pencil
- To be logged onto a computer classroom computer (log in instructions are on each computer)

Step 1

Go to the Washington State Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction – OSPI Website and find the data needed to complete the WASL Trend/EALRs Learning Targets Worksheet for your school.

Step 2

Fill in the WASL Trend/EALRs Learning Targets Worksheet. To get your school's AYP information, go to <http://reportcard.ospi.k12.wa.us>.

Step 3

Identify a WASL curriculum area as a focus for your collaboration with teachers.

Step 4

Using the EALRs outline, identify Learning Targets in that curriculum area.

Step 5

Use these learning targets in your collaborative planning with teachers.

Step 6

Use these learning targets in your reports and memos.
